REPORT

The Electoral Boundaries Commission for British Columbia, constituted in accordance with section 3 of the *Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act*, submits herewith its report in pursuance of section 12 of that Act.

The members of the Commission appointed in accordance with the provisions of sections 5, 6, and 7 of the Act are:

Chairman:	The Honourable Mr. Justice Harold W. McInnes, Vancouver, British Columbia.
Deputy Chairman:	George F. Curtis, Vancouver, British Columbia.
Member:	Roderick L. H. Haig-Brown, Campbell River, British Columbia.
Member:	Nelson Castonguay, Ottawa, Ontario.
Secretary:	Mrs. Doreen Gracey, Vancouver, British Columbia.

The Dominion Statistician, in accordance with section 11 of the Act, submitted to the Representation Commissioner his return and this was received by the Chairman of the Commission on January 22, 1965, together with the calculation by the Representation Commissioner, as prescribed by section 12 of the Act. The return showed the population of the province to be 1,629,082.

The Representation Commissioner calculated that twenty-three (23) members shall be assigned to said province. This was published in the *Canada Gazette* under date of November 28, 1964. The quota was then calculated to be 70,830.

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The Commission held its first meeting for the transaction of business at Vancouver, British Columbia, on January 23, 1965, and since that date has been engaged upon its duties.

The Representation Commissioner, in accordance with section 8 (1) of the *Representation Commissioner Act* (12 Elizabeth II, chapter 40), presented his alternative proposals to the Commission for examination but in the final analysis these had to be rejected and the Commission formulated its own recommendations.

The Commission, pursuant to the directions contained in the *Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act*, divided the province into twenty-three (23) electoral districts bounded as shown in the Notice published in accordance with section 17 (2) of the Act, in the *Canada Gazette* of May 19, 1965, and in newspapers throughout the province, giving notice of the time and place fixed for the hearing of representations from interested persons. As part of that advertisement were the determinations of the Commission comprising the names and descriptions of the electoral districts and the maps illustrating the electoral boundaries. Also published was a statement that notice of intention to make representations was required to be lodged with the Secretary to the Commission within twenty-three (23) days from the date of publication of the advertisement hereinbefore referred to, namely, on or before June 11, 1965.

The Commission sat throughout the province at the various places set forth in the notice referred to in the preceding paragraph hereof and at such sittings heard a total of forty-four (44) representations supported by persons appearing before the Commission. As a result of the representations certain changes have been incorporated in its recommendations to divide the province into twenty-three (23) electoral districts.

SCHEDULE A

Description of the names and boundaries of the electoral districts

There shall be in the province of British Columbia twenty-three electoral districts, each of which shall return one member. The Commission proposes that the electoral districts be named and described as follows.

In the following descriptions reference to roads, water features, railways and pipelines signifies the centre line of said roads, water features, railways and pipelines unless otherwise described.

1. BURNABY—RICHMOND consisting of the territory bounded as follows: commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the province of British Columbia and the easterly boundary of Delta District Municipality; thence northerly and westerly along said boundary to the Fraser River; thence northeasterly along said river to the southeasterly limit of the City of New Westminster; thence southwesterly along said limit to the west limit of said city; thence northerly along said west limit across Lulu Island and up the North Arm of Fraser River to the southeasterly projection of Fenwick Avenue; thence northwesterly along said projection, Fenwick Avenue and Marine Drive to Tenth (10th) Avenue; thence easterly along Tenth (10th) Avenue and its projection to the former British Columbia Electric Railway Line; thence northwesterly along said railway line to Imperial Street; thence westerly along Imperial Street to the east limit of the City of Vancouver; thence south along said east limit to the southerly limit of said City of Vancouver; thence westerly along said southerly limit to the west boundary of Richmond District Municipality; thence south along said west boundary and its projection south to the south boundary of the province of British Columbia; thence east along said south boundary to the point of commencement.

2. BURNABY—SEYMOUR consisting of the territory bounded as follows: commencing at the intersection of the former British Columbia Electric Railway Line and the projection of Byrne Road; thence easterly along Byrne Road

and Nineteenth (19th) Street to Edmonds Street; thence northeasterly along Edmonds Street to Grandview Highway; thence northwesterly along Grandview Highway to Sperling Avenue; thence northerly along Sperling Avenue to Hastings Street; thence easterly along Hastings Street to Inlet Drive; thence northerly along Inlet Drive to Pandora Street; thence easterly on Pandora Street and its easterly projection to the northerly projection of Phillips Avenue; thence northerly along said northerly projection to the south shore of Burrard Inlet; thence northerly in a straight line to the southeast corner of the North Vancouver District Municipality; thence northerly and westerly along the easterly and northerly boundaries of said municipality to the intersection of said northerly boundary with the projection northerly of Fromme Road; thence southerly along said projection and continuing along Fromme Road and its projection southerly to the boundary of said municipality lying along the projection of Twentieth (20th) Street; thence easterly along said boundary, projection and street to Arborlynn Drive; thence due east to Hastings Creek; thence southerly along Hastings Creek to Lynn Creek; thence southerly along Lynn Creek to the east limit of the City of North Vancouver; thence southerly along said east limit and its projection southerly to the north limit of the City of Vancouver; thence easterly along said north limit to the east limit of the City of Vancouver; thence south along said east limit to Imperial Street; thence easterly along Imperial Street to the former British Columbia Electric Railway Line; thence southeasterly along said railway line to the point of commencement.

3. CAPILANO consisting of the territory bounded as follows: commencing at the intersection of northerly projection of Fromme Road with the northerly boundary of the District Municipality of North Vancouver; thence westerly along said northerly boundary and the northerly boundary of the District Municipality of West Vancouver to the east shore of Queen Charlotte Channel; thence northwesterly and westerly around the north end of Bowen Island and Hutt Island; thence southerly through Collingwood Channel to a point opposite the en-
