Membership of Commission:

The Chairman of the Commission on the 22nd day of January, A.D. 1965, received from the Representation Commissioner the return as provided by Section 11 of the *Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act*, 13 ELIZABETH II, Chapter 31.

Calculation of the number of members of the House of Commons by the Representation Commissioner pursuant to Section 12 of the Act indicates that the Province of Ontario was assigned 88 members. Dividing the population of the Province by the number of members of the House of Commons assigned to the Province gives the electoral quota for the Province of Ontario of 70,865.

The Representation Commissioner, as provided by the *Representation Commissioner Act*, 12 ELIZABETH II, Chapter 40, Section 8(1), supplied maps and alternative proposals to the Commission. These were used as a starting point only.

Thereafter, and before making this report, the Commission proceeded after consideration of the rules provided in Section 13 and having had the assistance provided under Sections 14 and 15 of the Act, caused a statement of the proposed division of the Province into electoral districts to be published in the *Canada Gazette* on the 15th day of June, A.D. 1965.

In addition thereto and as provided in the statement so published in the *Canada Gazette*, public sittings were held throughout the Province at the following places and locations to hear representations by interested persons:

SCHEDULE A

Names and descriptions of electoral districts

There shall be in the province of Ontario eighty-eight electoral districts, each of which shall return one member. The Commission proposes that the electoral districts be named and described as follows.

In the following descriptions reference to roads, water features and railways signifies the centre line of said roads, water features and railways unless otherwise described; and all cities, towns, villages and Indian Reserves lying within the perimeter of the electoral district are included unless otherwise described.

1. ALGOMA consisting of:

- (a) that part of the territorial district of Algoma lying east and south of a line described as follows: commencing at the intersection of the east limit of the City of Sault Ste. Marie with the International Boundary; thence northerly along said east city limit to the southeast corner of the Township of Awere; thence northerly to the northwest corner of the Township of Duncan; thence easterly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Duncan and Kehoe to the northeast corner of the Township of Kehoe; thence southerly to the southwest corner of the Township of Chesley; thence easterly to the southeast corner of said Township; thence southerly to the southwest corner of the Township of Gillmor; thence easterly along the south boundaries of the Townships of Gillmor, 201, 195, 1F, 1E, 1D, 1C, 1B, 1A, U, Q, M, I and E to the northeast corner of Township 125;
- (b) that part of the territorial district of Manitoulin lying west and south of a line described as follows: commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of the Township of Curtin with the east boundary of Whitefish Indian Reserve No. 4; thence southeasterly and southwesterly along the shore of said Indian Reserve to a point due east of McGregor Bay Railway Station; thence southeasterly through the channel between McGregor

Point and Little Cloche Island; thence southerly to a point half way between Southeast Point on Haywood Island and Indian Dock Point on Manitoulin Island; thence due east in a line to its intersection with the southerly production of the east boundary of the territorial district of Manitoulin;

- (c) that part of the territorial district of Sudbury contained in the Townships of Baldwin, Curtin, Foster, Hallam, Harrow, May, Merritt, Mongowin, McKinnon, Nairn and Salter.

2. BRANT consisting of:

- (a) that part of the County of Brant contained in the Townships of Brantford, South Dumfries and Onondaga excepting that part of the Township of Onondaga contained in Six Nations Indian Reserve No. 40;
- (b) that part of the County of Wentworth contained in the Township of Ancaster excepting the Town of Dundas.

3. BROADVIEW consisting of that part of Metropolitan Toronto bounded as follows: commencing at the intersection of the Don River with the northerly production of the north-south branch of Donlands Avenue; thence northerly, westerly and southerly following the Don River to Lake Shore Boulevard East; thence westerly along Lake Shore Boulevard East to Cherry Street; thence southerly along Cherry Street and the southerly production of Cherry Street to the shore of Lake Ontario; thence easterly following the shore of Lake Ontario to its intersection with the southerly production of Leslie Street; thence northerly along said production and Leslie Street to the C.N.R. line; thence southwesterly along the C.N.R. line to Jones Avenue; thence northerly along Jones Avenue to Danforth Avenue; thence easterly along Danforth Avenue to Dewhurst Boulevard; thence northerly along Dewhurst Boulevard to Milverton Boulevard; thence easterly along Milverton Boulevard to the north-south branch of Donlands Avenue; thence northerly along the north-south branch of Donlands Avenue and the said northerly production of the north-south branch of Donlands Avenue to the point of commencement.

4. BRUCE consisting of:

- (a) the County of Bruce including the whole of the Village of Lucknow;

Dans la province d'Ontario, il y a quatre-vingt-huit circonscriptions électorales, chacune doit élire un député. La Commission propose que les circonscriptions soient nommées et décrites comme suit.

Dans les descriptions, la référence aux routes, aux caractéristiques de l'eau et aux chemins de fer signifie, à moins d'indication contraire, la ligne médiane des routes, des caractéristiques de l'eau et des voies ferrées. COCHRANE consisting of those parts of the territorial districts of Algoma, Cochrane, Kenora (Patricia Portion), Sudbury and Timiskaming bounded as follows: commencing at the intersection of the Interprovincial Boundary between Ontario and Quebec with the northern limit of the province; thence southerly along said Interprovincial Boundary to the north boundary of the Township of Bradette; thence westerly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Bradette, Noseworthy, Hoblitzell, Blakelock, Tweed and McQuibban; thence southerly along the west boundaries of the Townships of McQuibban, Sangster, Heighington and Dempsay; thence westerly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Fox, Brower, Lamarche, Fournier and Ottawa; thence southerly along the east boundaries of the Townships of Lennox, Nesbitt, Crawford, Carnegie and Kidd; thence westerly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Jessop, Jamieson, Robb and Côté; thence southerly along the west boundaries of the Townships of Côté, Massey and Whitesides; thence easterly along the boundary between the territorial districts of Cochrane and Timiskaming to the northeast corner of the Township of Eldorado; thence southerly along the east boundaries of the Townships of Eldorado, Douglas, Geikie and Zavitz; thence westerly along the south boundaries of the Townships of Zavitz, English, Beemer, Hassard, McBride and Crothers to the east boundary of the Township of Regan; thence northerly along said east boundary; thence westerly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Regan, Hardiman, Horwood and Silk; thence southerly along the west boundary of the Township of Silk; thence westerly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Biggs, Hellyer and Sandy; thence southerly along the west boundaries of the Townships of Sandy, Crockett and Halerow; thence westerly along the south boundaries of the Townships of Lackner, McNaught, Gallagher, Chapleau and Township 32; thence southerly along the east boundary of the Township of Hoey; thence westerly along the south boundaries of the Townships of Hoey, Triquet and Topham; thence southerly along the boundary between the territorial districts of Sudbury and Algoma to the northwest

corner of Township 23, range 14; thence easterly and southerly along the said boundary between the territorial districts of Sudbury and Algoma to the southeast corner of Township A; thence westerly along the south boundaries of said Township A and Townships E, I, M, Q, U, 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1F, 195 and 201 to the southwest corner of the Township of Gillmor; thence northerly to the southeast corner of the Township of Chesley; thence westerly to the east boundary of the Township of Kehoe; thence northerly to the northeast corner of said Township; thence westerly along the north boundaries of the Townships of Kehoe and Duncan to the northwest corner of the Township of Duncan; thence southerly along the west boundary of the Township of Duncan to the southeast corner of the Township of Aweres; thence westerly along the south boundaries of the Townships of Aweres, Pennefather and Dennis to the shore line of Lake Superior; thence due west to the International Boundary; thence northwesterly along the International Boundary to the west boundary of the territorial district of Algoma; thence northerly along said west boundary to the southwest corner of Township 65; thence easterly along the south boundaries of Townships 65, 64, 63, 62, 61, Tilston, Pearkes, St. Julien, Challenger and Acton to the boundary between the territorial districts of Sudbury and Algoma; thence easterly along said boundary to the southeast corner of the Township of Loughheed; thence northerly and westerly along the boundary between the territorial districts of Cochrane and Algoma to the east boundary of the territorial district of Thunder Bay; thence northerly along the east boundary of the territorial district of Thunder Bay to the south boundary of the territorial district of Cochrane at the northeast corner of the Township of Bell; thence westerly and northerly along the boundary of the territorial district of Cochrane to its northern end in the Albany River; thence due north to the northern limit of the province; thence easterly along said limit to the point of commencement.
