#### REPORT

The Electoral Boundaries Commission for Manitoba constituted in accordance with Section three of the *Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act* 1964 (13 Elizabeth II, chapter 31) submits its Report in pursuance of Section twelve of that Act.

The Members of the Commission for Manitoba appointed in accordance with the provisions of Sections five and six of the Act are:

Chairman: Mr. Justice Robert DuVal Guy,

Justice of the Court of Appeal of Manitoba.

Deputy Chairman: Dr. Hugh Hamilton Saunderson,

President of the University of Manitoba.

Member: Mr. Charland Prud'homme,

Clerk of the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba, Deputy Provincial Secretary of the Province of

Manitoba.

Member: Mr. Nelson Castonguay,

Representation Commissioner.

The Commission was established by Proclamation published in the Canada Gazette on January 20, 1965. The Commission held its first meeting for the transaction of business at Winnipeg, Manitoba, on January 27, 1965, and since that date has been engaged upon its duties.

Pursuant to Section eleven of the Act, the Representation Commissioner sent to the Chairman of the Commission the Return showing the population of Canada, and in particular the population of the Province of Manitoba which was stated to be 921,686. Pursuant to Section twelve of the Act, the Representation Commissioner advised the Chairman of the Manitoba Commission that thirteen Members would be assigned to this Province. The quota was then calculated to be 70,899.

The Manitoba Commission obtained from the Representation Commissioner a number of maps or alternative proposals prepared in accordance with Section eight (1) of the Representation Commissioner Act 1963 (12 Elizabeth II, chapter 40). It appeared that these maps were based on mathematical census data, and had been prepared using varying percentages above and below the quota for our Province. The Commission found these maps very helpful as a guide, but did not make use of any of them as such in the preparation of its proposals.

The Commission, on the basis of the information submitted above, proceeded to divide the Province into thirteen electoral districts pursuant to the directions contained in the *Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act*.

In accordance with Section seventeen (2) of the Act, an advertisement was duly published in the Canada Gazette on July 7, 1965, and in newspapers throughout the Province, giving notice of the times and places fixed for the hearing of representations from interested persons. As part of that advertisement were the determinations of the Commission comprising the names and descriptions of the electoral districts and the maps illustrating the electoral boundaries. Also published was a statement that any representations were required to be lodged with the Secretary of the Commission on or before July 30, 1965.

The Commission held five public hearings, and heard these representations at the following times and places:

In all, twenty-one representations were heard.

Following the hearing of the representations, further consideration was given to the proposed map, and the Schedules listed hereunder show the results of the modifications of the original proposal which have been agreed upon and given effect to by this Report.

The foregoing, with its attendant Schedules A, B, and C, constitutes our Report which is respectfully submitted at Winnipeg, this 2nd day of November, 1965.

#### SCHEDULE A

## Legal descriptions of the boundaries of the thirteen electoral districts in Manitoba

There shall be in the province of Manitoba thirteen electoral districts, each of which shall return one member. The Commission proposes that the electoral districts be named and described as follows.

In the following descriptions reference to roads signifies the centre line of said roads unless otherwise described; and sections, townships, ranges and meridians are in accordance with the Dominion Lands system of survey and include the extension thereof in accordance with said system.

- 1. BRANDON-SOURIS consisting of townships one (1) to twelve (12) inclusive in ranges twenty-three (23) to twenty-nine (29) inclusive; townships one (1) to ten (10) inclusive in ranges nineteen (19) to twenty-two (22) inclusive; townships seven (7) and eight (8) in range eighteen (18); all that portion of township nine (9) in said range eighteen (18) lying southwest of the Assiniboine River; the west half of township ten (10) in said range eighteen (18); all that portion of the east half of said township ten (10) in said range eighteen (18) lying southwest of the said river; township seven (7) in range seventeen (17) and all those portions of townships eight (8) and nine (9) in said range seventeen (17) lying southwest of the said river; all the aforesaid lands being west of the principal meridian.
- 2. CHURCHILL consisting of all the territory bounded as follows: on the north by the northern boundary of the province of Manitoba; on the east by the eastern boundary of the said province; on the west by the western boundary of the said province and on the south by the following described line: commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township thirty-eight (38) with the eastern boundary of the said province; thence westerly along the said north boundary of township thirty-eight (38) to the eastern shore line of Lake Winnipeg; thence in a general southeasterly direction following the sinuosities of the said shore line to the most western part of Clements Point in township twenty-five (25) in range eight (8) east of the principal meridian; thence southwesterly in a straight line to the most southerly point of Hecla Island; thence northwesterly in a straight line to the point where the north boundary of township twentythree (23) intersects the western shore line of the said lake, and including any part of said

Hecla Island which may lie southerly of the said straight lines; thence westerly along the said north boundary of township twenty-three (23) to its intersection with the western shore line of Lake Manitoba; thence in a general northerly direction following the sinuosities of the said shore line of Lake Manitoba to the most easterly part of Big Sandy Point in township twenty-nine (29) in range twelve (12) west of the principal meridian; thence northwesterly in a straight line to the most southerly part of Pole Point in township thirty (30) in range thirteen (13) west of the principal meridian; thence in a general northerly direction following the sinuosities of the northeasterly shore line of Lake Manitoba to the east boundary of range fifteen (15) west of the principal meridian; thence northerly along the said east boundary of range fifteen (15) to the north boundary of township thirty-five (35); thence westerly along the said north boundary of township thirty-five (35) to the western shore line of Lake Winnipegosis: thence northerly along the said western shore line of Lake Winnipegosis to the north boundary of Indian Reserve No. 66A; thence westerly and then southerly along the north and west boundaries respectively of the said Indian Reserve to the said north boundary of township thirty-five (35); thence westerly along the said north boundary of township thirty-five (35) to the east boundary of range twenty-three (23) west of the principal meridian; thence northerly along the said east boundary of range twenty-three (23) to the southern shore line of Swan Lake; thence in a general northerly direction following the sinuosities of the said shore line of Swan Lake to the east boundary of range twenty-four (24) west of the principal meridian; thence northerly along the said east boundary of range twenty-four (24) to the north boundary of township forty-two (42); thence westerly along the said north boundary of township forty-two (42) to the east boundary of range twenty-five (25) west of the principal meridian; thence northerly along the said east boundary of range twenty-five (25) to the north boundary of township forty-four (44); thence westerly along the said north boundary of township forty-four (44) to the west boundary of the said province of Manitoba.

3. DAUPHIN consisting of the territory described as follows: commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township twenty-two (22) with the west boundary of the province of Manitoba; thence easterly along the said north boundary of township twenty-two (22) to the eastern boundary of Riding

to the north boundary of township forty-two (42); thence westerly along the said north boundary of township forty-two (42) to the east boundary of range twenty-five (25); thence northerly along the said east boundary of range twenty-five (25) to the north boundary of township forty-four (44); thence westerly along the said north boundary of township forty-four (44) to the said west boundary of the province of Manitoba; thence southerly along the said west boundary of the province of to the point of commencement, the above described territory being all west of the principal meridian.

4. LISGAR consisting of those townships, parts of townships and river lots lying west of the Red River, east of the principal meridian, and south of township eight (8); townships one (1) to seven (7) inclusive in ranges one (1) to seven (7) inclusive; townships one (1) to eight (8) inclusive in range eight (8); that part of township nine (9) in range eight (8) lying south and east of the centre line of the Assiniboine River; those townships and parts of townships lying south of the centre line of the said Assiniboine River in ranges nine (9) to sixteen (16) inclusive; townships one (1) to six (6) inclusive in ranges seventeen (17) and eighteen (18), all said ranges being west of the principal meridian: together with all Indian Reserves lying within the above described lands; excepting out of the above described lands all that portion contained within the limits of the town of Emerson lying west of the said Red River.

5. 6. PORTAGE consisting of the territory described as follows: commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township twenty-three (23) with the western shore line of Lake Manitoba; thence southerly following the said western shore line, crossing the mouth of Ebb and Flow Lake and thence continuing southerly along the said shore line to its intersection with the east boundary of range nine (9) west of the principal meridian; thence southerly along said east boundary of range nine (9) to the north boundary of township

nine (9); thence easterly along the said north boundary of township nine (9) to the northeast corner of section thirty-one (31) in township nine (9) in range eight (8) west of the principal meridian; thence southerly along the east boundary of said section thirty-one (31) and along the east boundaries of sections thirty (30) and nineteen (19) in said township nine (9) in range eight (8) to the centre line of the Assiniboine River; thence easterly and then northerly following the said centre line to the said north boundary of township nine (9); thence easterly along said north boundary of township nine (9) to the east boundary of range eight (8) west of the principal meridian; thence southerly along the said east boundary of range eight (8) to the north boundary of township seven (7); thence easterly along the said north boundary of township seven (7) and along the north boundary of river lot six hundred and twenty-three (623) of the parish of Ste. PROVENCHER consisting of the territory bounded as follows: on the south by the south boundary of the province of Manitoba; on the east by the east boundary of the said province; on the north by the north boundary of township thirty-eight (38) and on the west by the following described line: commencing at the intersection of the said north boundary of township thirty-eight (38) with the eastern shore line of Lake Winnipeg; thence in a general southerly direction following the sinuosities of the said shore line to the intersection of the southern shore line of the said lake with the east boundary of the westerly two-thirds of township sixteen (16) in range six (6), but including Elk Island in the said lake; thence southerly along the said east boundary of the westerly two-thirds of township sixteen (16), and along the east boundaries of the westerly twothirds of townships fifteen (15), fourteen (14), and thirteen (13) in said range six (6) to the north boundary of the municipality of Springfield; thence westerly, then southwesterly and then in a general southerly direction following the northern, northwestern and western boundaries respectively of the said municipality of Springfield to the south boundary of said municipality; thence easterly along the said south boundary of the said municipality to the east boundary of the west half of township nine (9) in range four (4); thence southerly along the said east boundary of the west half of township nine (9) and along the east boundary of the west half of township eight (8) in said range four (4) to the north boundary of township seven (7); thence westerly along the said north
