The Electoral Boundaries Commission for the Province of Alberta, established under the provisions of the *Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act*, 13 Elizabeth II, chapter 31 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") submits this report as required by Section 12 of the Act.

The return of the Representation Commissioner under Section 11 of the Act was received by the Chairman of the Commission on January 22, 1965.

The Commission held its first meeting at Calgary, Alberta, on January 25, 1965, and since that date has been engaged with all reasonable despatch in the preparation of this report.

In the issue of the *Canada Gazette* dated November 28, 1964, there appeared the result of the calculation made by the Representation Commissioner pursuant to Section 12 of the Act showing that 19 members had been assigned to the Province of Alberta.

The Commission received from the Representation Commissioner a copy of the return made to him by the Dominion Statistician pursuant to Section 11 of the Act certifying that the population of the Province of Alberta for the census taken in 1961 was 1,331,944.

The quotient obtained by dividing 1,331,944 (the population of the Province of Alberta) by 19 (the number of members assigned), as directed by Section 13(a) of the Act, was found to be 70,102.

The Commission received from the Representation Commissioner maps showing the distribution of population in the Province of Alberta and setting out alternative proposals respecting the boundaries of electoral districts in the province, as directed by Section 8 of the *Representation Commissioner Act*, 12 Elizabeth II, chapter 40. These were found to be helpful but, after careful study, were considered unsuitable. They were rejected by the Commission in favour of its own proposals.

The Commission divided the province into 19 electoral districts and described the boundaries of each pursuant to the rules set forth in Section 13 of the Act. For each of these electoral districts it then proposed a name as required by Section 12.

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On June 26, 1965, the Commission caused to be published in the *Canada Gazette* an advertisement complying with the requirements of Section 17 of the Act. There being no English-language newspaper of general circulation in the province, this advertisement was published in several newspapers whose collective circulation covered the Province of Alberta. The advertisement was also published in a French-language newspaper of general circulation amongst the French-speaking people in Alberta.

The Commission sat from time to time throughout the province at the several places set forth in the advertisement. At such sittings it heard representations from a total of 37 persons who appeared before it.

The Commission gave consideration to these representations. They served to confirm the Commission in its proposals as published except for the desirability of changing two names and of removing local anomalies from the perimeters of some electoral districts. The Commission has incorporated these changes into its recommendations.

Attached to this report is a schedule containing the names of the recommended electoral districts with a description of the boundaries and population of each, and maps (in pocket) depicting the boundaries.

The Commission's recommendations concerning the division of the Province of Alberta into electoral districts, and its recommendations concerning the description of the boundaries of each such district, and the representation and name to be given thereto, as required by Section 12 of the Act, are set forth in Schedule A hereto.

Le 26 juin 1965, la Commission a fait publier dans la *Gazette du Canada* une annonce répondant aux exigences de la section 17 de la Loi. N'y ayant pas dans la province un journal d'expression anglaise de circulation générale, cette annonce a été publiée dans plusieurs journaux dont la circulation collective couvre la province de l'Alberta. L'annonce a également été publiée dans un journal d'expression française de circulation générale parmi les francophones de l'Alberta.

La Commission a tenu des séances de temps en temps dans différentes parties de la province aux fins de recevoir les représentations des personnes qui se sont présentées devant elle. Au total, 37 personnes ont comparu devant elle.

La Commission a examiné ces représentations. Elles ont servi à confirmer la Commission dans ses propositions publiées, à l'exception de la modification de deux noms et de l'élimination d'anomalies locales des périmètres de certains districts électoraux. La Commission a incorporé ces changements dans ses recommandations.

Elle joint au présent rapport un tableau contenant les noms des districts électoraux recommandés, une description des limites et de la population de chacun, ainsi que des cartes (en poche) illustrant les limites.

L'annexe A du présent rapport contient les recommandations de la Commission en ce qui concerne la division de la province de l'Alberta en districts électoraux, ainsi que ses recommandations en ce qui concerne la description des limites de chacun de ces districts, la représentation et le nom à donner à chacun d'eux, comme requis par la section 12 de la Loi, sont énoncés dans l'annexe A.

SCHEDULE A

Names of the recommended electoral districts and a description of the boundaries and population of each such district

There shall be in the province of Alberta nineteen electoral districts, each of which shall return one member. The Commission proposes that the electoral districts be named and described as follows.

In the following descriptions reference to roads signifies the centre line of said roads unless otherwise described; sections, townships, ranges and meridians are in accordance with the Dominion Lands system of survey and include the extension thereof in accordance with said system; and the bank of a river is referred to as the right or left bank, according to whether it is to the right or left respectively on facing downstream.

1. ATHABASCA consisting of all that portion of the Province of Alberta lying east of the westerly boundary, and north of the southerly boundary, as described below:

The westerly boundary

(NOTE: all ranges mentioned in this portion of the description lie west of the fifth (5th) meridian.)

Starting at the northeast corner of township sixty-seven (67) range twenty (20); thence northerly along the east boundary of range twenty (20) to the northeast corner of township seventy-three (73); thence east to the northeast corner of township seventy-three (73) range nineteen (19); thence northerly along the east boundary of range nineteen (19) to the northeast corner of township seventy-nine (79) range nineteen (19); thence west to the northeast corner of township seventy-nine (79) range twenty-two (22); thence north to the northeast corner of township eighty (80) range twenty-two (22); thence west to a point where the north boundary of township eighty (80) intersects the right bank of the Smoky River; thence downstream along the right bank of the Smoky River to its junction with the Peace River; thence downstream along the right bank of the Peace River to its intersection with the north boundary of township one hundred and four (104); thence west to the northeast corner of township one hundred and four (104) range twenty (20);

thence northerly along the east boundary of range twenty (20) to the northeast corner of township one hundred and ten (110); thence east to the southeast corner of township one hundred and eleven (111) range nineteen (19); thence northerly along the east boundary of range nineteen (19) to the north boundary of the Province of Alberta.

The southerly boundary

Starting at the northeast corner of township sixty-seven (67) range twenty (20) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence east to the northeast corner of township sixty-seven (67) range eight (8) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence north to the northeast corner of township seventy (70) range eight (8) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence east to the point where the north boundary of township seventy (70) range one (1) west of the fifth (5th) meridian intersects the right bank of the Athabasca River; thence downstream along the right bank of the Athabasca River to its intersection with the north boundary of township sixty-nine (69) range twenty-three (23) west of the fourth (4th) meridian; thence east to the northeast corner of township sixty-nine (69) range eighteen (18) west of the fourth (4th) meridian; thence southerly along the east boundary of range eighteen (18) to the northeast corner of township sixty (60); thence east to the northeast corner of township sixty (60) range eight (8) west of the fourth (4th) meridian; thence southerly along the east boundary of range eight (8) to a point where the east boundary of range eight (8) intersects the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence downstream along the left bank of the said river to its intersection with the east boundary of the Province of Alberta.

2. BATTLE RIVER consisting of townships forty-two (42) to forty-seven (47) inclusive in ranges one (1) to twenty-two (22) inclusive; townships thirty-nine (39) to forty-one (41) inclusive in ranges one (1) to twenty-five (25) inclusive, excluding that portion of township thirty-nine (39) in ranges twenty-two (22) and twenty-three (23) lying south of the left bank of the Red Deer River; those portions of township thirty-eight (38) in ranges twenty-three (23) to twenty-five (25) inclusive lying north of the left bank of the Red Deer River; townships thirty-seven (37) and thirty-eight (38) in ranges one (1) to twenty-one (21) inclusive, and those portions of said townships lying east of the left bank of the Red Deer River in range twenty-two (22); all the aforesaid lands being west of the fourth (4th) meridian.

Dans la province d'Alberta, il y a dix-neuf circonscriptions électorales, chacune devant élire un député. La Commission propose que les circonscriptions soient nommées et décrites comme il suit :

Dans les descriptions, les références aux routes publiques signifient la ligne médiane de la route, à moins qu'il n'en soit autrement mentionné; les sections, les townships, les ranges et les méridiens sont conformes au système des terres du Canada; les extensions de ces divisions sont conformes au système; et le bord d'un cours d'eau est désigné comme étant le bord droit ou gauche, selon qu'on se trouve en amont ou en aval de la rivière.

1. ATHABASCA, qui comprend toute la partie de la province d'Alberta située à l'est de la limite occidentale et au nord de la limite méridionale, décrite ci-dessous :

La limite occidentale

(Note: Tous les ranges mentionnés dans cette partie de la description se trouvent à l'ouest du cinquième (5^e) méridien.)

CALGARY CENTRE is contained within the boundary described as follows: Starting at the point where Highway number One (No. 1) intersects the east boundary of section twenty-four (24) township twenty-four (24) range two (2) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence easterly along Highway number One (No. 1) to Twenty-four (24) Street N.W.; thence easterly along Sixteen (16) Avenue N.W. to Centre Street; thence southerly along Centre Street, across the Bow River, to the north boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way; thence easterly along the said right-of-way boundary to Second (2nd) Street S.E.; thence south to Seventeen (17) Avenue S.E.; thence westerly along Seventeen (17) Avenue S.E. to Four (4) Street S.W.; thence southerly along Four (4) Street S.W. to Twenty-five (25) Avenue S.W.; thence westerly along Twenty-five (25) Avenue S.W. to Hillcrest Avenue; thence westerly along Hillcrest Avenue to Eight (8) Street S.W.; thence southerly along Eight (8) Street S.W. to Frontenac Avenue; thence northwesterly along Frontenac Avenue to Fourteen (14) Street S.W.; thence southerly along Fourteen (14) Street S.W. to Thirty-two (32) Avenue S.W.; thence westerly along Thirty-two (32) Avenue S.W. to its intersection with Richmond Road; thence southwest along Richmond Road to Forty-three (43) Street S.W.; thence northerly along Forty-three (43) Street S.W. to Twenty-six (26) Avenue S.W.; thence westerly along Twenty-six (26) Avenue S.W. to Forty-five (45) Street S.W.; thence northerly along Forty-five (45) Street S.W. to Seventeen (17) Avenue S.W.; thence easterly along Seventeen (17) Avenue S.W. to Thirty-seven (37) Street S.W.; thence northerly along Thirty-seven (37) Street S.W. and its northerly prolongation, across the Bow River, to the starting point.

CALGARY NORTH is contained within the boundary described as follows: Starting at the northeast corner of section one (1) township twenty-five (25) range two (2) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence east to the northeast corner of section two (2) township twenty-five (25) range one (1) west of the fifth (5th)

meridian; thence north to the north boundary of the south half of section twelve (12) township twenty-five (25) range one (1) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of the said half section to the fifth (5th) meridian (in Highway number 2); thence southerly along the fifth (5th) meridian to the northeast corner of section thirteen (13) township twenty-four (24) range one (1) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence east to the northeast corner of section fifteen (15) township twenty-four (24) range twenty-nine (29) west of the fourth (4th) meridian; thence southerly along Fifty-two (52) Street S.E. to its intersection with Eight (8) Avenue S.E.; thence east to the centre point of section fourteen (14) township twenty-four (24) range twenty-nine (29) west of the fourth (4th) meridian; thence southerly along the quarter line to its intersection with the northwest boundary of the Canadian National Railway right-of-way; thence southwest along the said boundary of the said right-of-way to its intersection with the easterly prolongation of Twenty-six (26) Avenue S.E.; thence westerly along said prolongation, Twenty-six (26) Avenue S.E. and its westerly prolongation, across the irrigation canal, to the left bank of the Bow River; thence upstream along the left bank of the Bow River, excluding all islands, to the intersection of Centre Street; thence northerly along Centre Street to Sixteen (16) Avenue N.W.; thence westerly along Sixteen (16) Avenue N.W. to Twenty-four (24) Street N.W.; thence along Highway number One (No. 1) to its intersection with the east boundary of section twenty-four (24) township twenty-four (24) range two (2) west of the fifth (5th) meridian; thence north to the starting point.

CALGARY SOUTH is contained within the boundary described as follows: Starting at the point where the left bank of the Bow River intersects Centre Street; thence downstream along the left bank of the Bow River, including all islands, to the point of intersection with the westerly prolongation of Twenty-six (26) Avenue S.E.; thence southerly along the left bank of the Bow River to its intersection with the fifth (5th) meridian; thence southerly along the fifth (5th) meridian to the northeast corner
